FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How much is the tuition fee?

The tuition fee is as follows:

- EUR 1,800.00 per year for all years of bachelor undergraduate studies, if the amount of tuition is paid at once in full at the beginning of the study year
- in case the student decides on the option of payment in 10 monthly installments, the tuition amount is EUR 1900.00 per year for all years of undergraduate studies
- 2000.00 euros per year for all years of master studies.

2. Is the study program licensed?

Both study programs are officially accredited by the Agency for Quality Control and Assurance in Higher Education at the Ministry of Education (Decision on Accreditation No. 02-060/19-3/2 dated January 25, 2019) and reaccredited by Decision No. 02-607/24-12/6 UPI dated January 31, 2024. for a period of 5 years. The faculty has a license to carry out these programs, as well as a license to engage in scientific and research activities and a license to work as an innovative organization.

3. What is required for enrollment?

For enrollment, it is necessary to submit the following documents (originals or certified copies):

- application form (available on the website or at the faculty)

- original certificate for all four grades of secondary school for basic studies, i.e. certificate of passed exams (diploma supplement) for master's studies
- original high school diploma, i.e. diploma of basic studies (certificate of graduation)
- a copy of the identity card

4. *What is written on the diploma? What title do I get?*

The title of the bachelor's degree is Bachelor of International Hotel and Gastronomy Management, and the title of the master's degree is Master of International Hotel and Gastronomy Management.

5. *I am currently working, can I study at the same time?*

In accordance with the Law on Higher Education, attendance at lectures is not a prerequisite for a student to be able to take an exam and complete his studies. However, everyone is advised to listen to the lectures and especially attend the practical lessons and exercises, which can hardly be compensated for by theoretical materials.

Considering that the lecturers are very dedicated to the personal and professional development of the students, at the beginning of each semester the schedule is organized in accordance with the possibilities of the group in order to make the teaching more efficient.

Also, thanks to the faculty's platform for distance learning, all learning materials are available to students who are unable to attend lectures on regular basis.

6. *Where is the faculty located?*

HEC Faculty is the first hotel-school in the region, designed after the famous Swiss colleges.

It is located in the Hotel Residence in Miločer, where students already during their studies become capable of applying their knowledge in the environment of a real hotel with real guests, and therefore significantly more competitive on the job market.

7. *Who are the lecturers?*

At HEC Faculty, we really gathered the best - both in theory and in practice. In addition to eminent doctors of science, the lecturers are also business experts who currently hold managerial positions in elite Montenegrin hotels and strengthen the practical dimension of the whole story.

We will mention only a few of them - Vuksan Mitrović (president of the Montenegro Chefs Association and lifetime honorary member of the World Association of Chefs), Svetozar Savić (winner of the Montenegro National July 13th Award and top expert in the field of wine and viticulture), Saša Čekrlija (author of the SuperHost program for the tourism industry), Mirjana Mrkalj (GM

of the Splendid Hotel in Bečići), Svetlana Šljivančanin (Ministry of Tourism of Montenegro), Bojana Kalenjuk (professor of gastronomy with PMF of the University of Novi Sad) and many others.

8. What can I continue after completing my studies?

Thanks to the Montenegrin diploma, students have access to master's studies at the HEC Faculty, where they obtain the title of Master of of International Hotel and Gastronomy Management. Also, students with completed basic studies at our faculty and a Montenegrin bachelor's degree have access to all European and international faculties.
